Are You Impacted by Domestic Violence?

<u>Physical Abuse:</u> Hitting, slapping, pushing, using weapons or force to cause harm

<u>Verbal Abuse:</u> Constant criticism, humiliation, yelling, insulting

<u>Sexual Abuse:</u> Forcing sex on or sexually touching an unwilling partner, demanding sexual acts or favors, degrading treatment

<u>Isolation:</u> Keeping victim away from friends & family, monitoring phone usage, controlling where victim goes, withholding car keys

<u>Coercion:</u> Making victim feel guilty, sulking, manipulating children or family, setting impossible rules and punishing victim for breaking them

<u>Harassment:</u> Stalking, following, embarrassing victim in public, refusing to leave or stop contacting when asked

<u>Economic Control:</u> Withholding money, keeping victim from work or school, not allowing the victim to get a job

<u>Threats & Intimidation:</u> Threatening to harm the victim, children, family, pets
